BLINKERS/HEADGEAR (REGULATIONS - APPENDIX R)

7.11 Owners/keepers are required at declaration to declare if their horse is to wear headgear of any kind – blinkers, eye shield, hood, visor, eyecover or sheepskin cheek pieces – or any combination thereof.

Clerks of Scales, Declaration Clerks and Stewards in particular are asked to take note of the requirements of Regulations 24(iii) and 119.

Red Hoods

Anybody wishing for their horse to wear a red hood in the parade ring and on the way to the start should request the permission of the Stewards before doing so and, at the time of being given permission, be reminded that the hood MUST be removed at the start and to ensure that they send somebody down to the start to remove it/collect it.
