

STOP-RACE FLAG



RIDERS MUST PULL UP

WHEN AN ORANGE AND YELLOW FLAG HAS BEEN DEPLOYED IT SIGNIFIES THAT THE STOP-RACE PROCEDURES HAVE BEEN IMPLEMENTED (A WHISTLE WILL ALSO BE BLOWN TO DRAW RIDERS' ATTENTION TO THE FLAG). RIDERS MUST PULL UP.

Regulation

Regulation 122(vi) Where a pre-determined person(s) waves a stop-race flag indicating that it is unsafe to proceed at any time in the course of a race, each rider who has not passed the flag must pull up, and the race shall be void. A rider who ignores the stop race procedure will be guilty of an offence.

Penalty

Any rider failing to pull up will be fined £250.
