

CONCLUSION OF THE MEETING

IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE FIXTURE (WITHIN TWO DAYS)

RETURN OF MARKED RACECARD AND OTHER DOCUMENTATION – BHA REQUIREMENT – INSTRUCTION 11.1

(NEEDED IN CASE OF OBJECTIONS OR FURTHER FUTURE ENQUIRIES)

Immediately following the Meeting, a marked Racecard showing all the runners, weights carried, placed horses, (and the distances between them), riders, overweights and race times (see Appendix (11)A), must be sent to the PPA.

It should also include headgear and going.

Written reports of all enquiries held and objections lodged must be submitted on the official form, together with any completed RQC declarations (Appendix (8)A) and cheques (payable to the Point-to-Point Authority) for any fines imposed.

MEDICAL REPORT FORMS (A and B) AND RIDER INJURY NOTIFICATION – BHA REQUIREMENT – INSTRUCTION 11.2

Medical Report Forms (A and B) MUST be returned to the BHA Medical Department WITHIN 24 hours of the meeting under separate cover by the (S)RMO. They can also be emailed direct to the Medical Department medical@britishhorseracing.com and it is strongly recommended that a copy of the forms are kept in case they fail to arrive.

The SRMO must, within three hours of the Meeting ending, send out a text message to the BHA CMA (07788 567440) informing them of any red entries or confirming there were none.

LATER

PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY – Reg 61 (iv) I.

Prize money must not be paid out until 15 days after a fixture to allow the BHA to raise objections. If nothing is heard, it should then be paid out immediately.

NB: reclaiming prize money already paid out takes time and patience. Conversely, failing to pay out in a timely fashion causes considerable irritation to owners and can lead to them boycotting that fixture in the future.

NATIONAL SPONSORSHIP OR OTHER GRANTS CONTROLLED BY THE PPA

A fixture needs to invoice the PPA for the money it expects to receive, with an explanatory e-mail if required.

ACCOUNTS AND HBLB GRANT – Reg 62

On completion of the fixture (or accepted abandonment), the Fixture Secretary will receive forms from the PPA office which require completing and signing, and should be returned within six weeks. Until these are returned, the HBLB grant cannot be made. However, it is also a Regulatory requirement, without which the Hunt/Club cannot run a fixture in the following year. Late delivery is also subject to a fine.

Weights: 12st for Horses and Geldings aged 6 years and older; 11st7lb for Mares of 6 years and older; 11st10lb for 5-y-o Horses and Geldings; 11st3lb for 5-y-o Mares; 11st for 4-y-o Horses and Geldings; 10st7lb for 4-y-o Mares.

Penalties: For each win on or since 1st October 2021 in a Steeplechase or Hurdle race under the Rules of any recognised Racing Authority (Point-to-Points excepted) to carry 7lb extra; for each win in a Mens, Ladies or Mixed Open Point-to-Point in this period to carry 5lb extra, and for each win in a Conditions race at the same Level or higher (to include Confined, Club Association, Service or Society Point-to-Point races) in this period to carry 3lb extra. Maximum penalty to be carried is 10lb.

Penalties are cumulative.
